

## ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

The Scientific Committee welcomes the submission of **free communication** abstracts for consideration to be presented at 2<sup>nd</sup> UMMC Nursing Congress 2008. Papers may report findings of particular studies (completed or in progress) and on topics directly related and relevant to this congress's theme. The official language of the congress is English.

- Abstracts should not be more than 150-200 words.
- Use 12-point font in Times New Roman.
- Include only text in the abstract, no tables or figures.
- No limits is imposed on the number of abstracts submitted by individuals (Please note only ONE paper will be selected for ORAL presentation. Remaining abstracts, if accepted may be presented as posters).
- Abstracts must be accompanied by payment of registration fees. If the abstract is subsequently not accepted for presentation, and the author wishes to cancel his participation, the registration fee will be refunded to the author.
- Scheduling details and guidelines for the final preparation of accepted presentation will be included with a notification of acceptance.
- The final selection will be the responsibility of the Scientific Committee.

### **1. Oral presentations: 15 minutes, followed by a 10 minutes questions period**

A scholarly examination of a topic related to the congress theme. The abstract should include:

- Clear indication of the subject matter
- Relevant literature review
- Discussion on its relevance to education/management/practice

OR

Abstract of clinical research/evidence-based practice projects should include:

- Research problem
- Research purpose
- Methodology
- Results
- Conclusions

## **2. Poster Presentation**

The size of the poster itself should be around 0.8 m (W) X 1 M to 1.5 M (H).  
It should include:

- Title and Author
- Content of the should include
  - Introduction, research purpose, methods, results, discussion, acknowledgements and references for completed or ongoing research projects
  - 
  - OR
  - Introduction, literature review, discussion and references for any relevant topic

Authors of abstracts are requested to register and fill out the abstract submission form and fax it to 03-79493740.
