

ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Overview

This course is aimed at equipping students with the knowledge, skills and characteristics required of a teacher in line with individual scope of practice. The course contains didactic and clinical components formulated in order to maximise application of the teaching-learning process in classroom and clinical settings. Student will study micro teaching skills and carry out teaching practice in the classroom and also in the clinical environment. Students will also visit several colleges of nursing or health science in order to observe and become involved in classroom and clinical teaching.

Benefits

At the end of the course, students will be able to:

- Identify teaching-learning requirements in the classroom and clinical environments.
- Formulate objectives, content and methodology in assessment.
- Formulate curricula in Nursing /Assistant Medical Officer and Health Science teaching.
- Apply knowledge, skills and personal characteristics in the teaching process.
- Apply micro teaching skills in the classroom and in clinical teaching.
- Assume the role of a competent and effective teacher according to individual scope of practice.
- Promote the importance of continuous education in the enhancement of professional and personal development.

Programme structure

Students must complete a **total of 40 credit hours** as required in order to qualify for the award of Executive Diploma. Each student must take and pass all courses prescribed as Core Courses and Teaching Practice.

Entry requirements

- ii. Registration with the Nursing Board of Malaysia.
- iii. At least 3 years' work experience following registration.
- iv. Confirmation of current post held.

Private organisation candidates

- i. Certificate/Diploma in Nursing.
- ii. Registration with the Nursing Board of Malaysia.
- iii. At least 1 year's work experience following registration, including at least 3 months' experience in the field applied for.
