#### What is ultrasound?

- An examination that uses sound waves to create images of organs and structures inside our body.
- Allows better visualization of muscles, tendons, and many internal organs, their sizes, structure and any abnormalities.

#### How is it done?

An ultrasound machine which has a hand-held probe is used to send the sound waves through the skin via water-based gel which is applied on the skin and images are taken.

# Any risks involved during the procedure?

- It is non ionizing radiation procedure, hence, it is thought to be harmless.
- Possibility of allergy to the water-based gel.

# How should I prepare?

- Neck/ limbs:
  - No preparation required.
- Abdomen (stomach/ liver/ gall bladder, spleen ):
  - Fasting required
- Kidney/ urinary bladder/ pelvis:
  - Full bladder required before the examination.

#### Patient preparation before ultrasound procedure

# **Morning appointment**:

You are required to fast at least 6 hours before the appointment time. You may consume plain water or tea/ coffee (without milk).

# **Afternoon appointment**:

Take light breakfast. You are required to fast at least 6 hours before the appointment time. You may consume plain water or tea/ coffee (without milk)

# Children:

Patient is required to fast 4 hours before the appointment time (plain water is allowed).
