- Abstract must be typed in Times New Roman font in 12-point type.
- Authors should include a short precise title in CAPITAL LETTERS within the top box, clearly defining the topic of the abstract.
- The authors' names, initials, their institutions and states should be listed immediately beneath the abstract title, typed in upper and lower case and single-spaced. The presenting author must be underlined.
- The abstract should be type-set in upper and lower case and single spaced. The format: Aims, Methods, Results, Conclusions is greatly recommended.
