DIPLOMA IN NURSING

Overview of Programme

The Diploma in Nursing Programme is offered by the College of Health Sciences, University of Malaya Medical Centre has been designed especially for school leavers who are interested to pursue their career in nursing. This program will provide the students with skills, knowledge and competencies required to be a confident and caring general nursing practitioner.

Our aim is to produce graduates who are caring and able to provide safe, competent, ethical and quality in nursing practice. Also, to enhance the growth and development of nurses and the nursing profession to meet the current needs and developments. The curriculum, course contents, academic standards and course evaluations are specifically designed to enable students to gain and develop the skills and knowledge relevant for a career in nursing.

Programme Educational Outcomes

The Diploma of Nursing Programme, should produce nurses who are:

- Knowledgeable and skillful in nursing profession in-line with the health care requirement.
- Able to communicate effectively and demonstrate good quality of leadership within the organization.
- Capable in solving health care problems systematically and ethically through sustainable approach.
- Able to realize the need of lifelong learning for career development.

Programme Learning Outcomes

At the end of this programme, students will be able to:

- Acquire and apply knowledge of health sciences, behavioral sciences and nursing sciences in nursing profession.
- Demonstrate safe and comprehensive skills in nursing profession.
- Provide a holistic care using systematic nursing process approach in health care system.

- Function effectively as individual or in teams, with a capability to be a leader.
- Understand and committed professionally and ethically in line with the nursing code of professional conduct.
- Recognize the need for and to engage in life-long learning and professional development.
- Self motivate and enhance entrepreneurship skills for career development.
- Demonstrate effective leadership responsibility.

Programme Structure

This is a three years full-time course. Course contents are divided almost equally between academic and clinical components. The academic components shall include lectures, tutorials, seminars and demonstrations sessions and the clinical components will include the clinical practice. The clinical placements are mainly in the various wards and clinics in the University Malaya Medical Centre. For the Community Health Nursing, students will be placed in the selected health clinics in Klang Valley. The curriculum covers the following courses:

Graduates of the Diploma in Nursing Programme will have the opportunity to further their studies in Advanced Diploma in Nursing, then later to Bachelor Degree, Master and PhD / Doctorate in related fields at local universities. Following this, by experiences and academic achievements, they may also be qualified to hold various posts up to management levels such as Ward Managers, Nursing Officers, Nursing Tutors or Lecturers, at the government departments, statutory bodies or private sectors, subject to the conditions of public services.

- Passed Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) or equivalent examination with: Credit in Bahasa Melayu (including passed in oral test), AND
- Credit in English and Mathematics, AND
- Obtain credits in two subjects and one of the subjects is Core Science (Sains Teras) or Pure Science (Sains Tulen) (priority in Biology subject).
